Sir,

My son-Master. Bhavya Jyoti Singh (DCS/1911006) had submitted student evaluation appeal form to HOD- CSE, regarding award of inappropriate GP grading in extraordinary circumstances of COVID- 19. Department of Computer Science & Engineering has followed criteria given at Page No. 28 of rules book for ICD, which was not applicable during COVID- 19 (extraordinary circumstances). There was national level lockdown in 4 semesters out of total 6 semesters. It was not possible for ICD students to participate in Institute level/State Level/University Level/National level activities (as per clause D12.10.3 of page No. 28 of rule book for ICD) due to lockdown.

It is requested to look into the matter by Chairman Senate because channel - HOD-CSE & Dean (Academics) have not given appropriate merit to the student evaluation appeal form submitted by son. It is requested to review the GP marks grading for whole class of DCS/19 batch.
